

# SECTION A - HORSES

RINGMASTER: Ms Ellen Lindsay – 0408 789 840

All horses competing at this Show compete on the understanding that drug testing may be carried out at the Show, and if drugs are detected then penalties will apply.

**RING ENTRIES:** 'Post' Entries. No entries will be accepted in advance (other than for Team Penning). Entry fees as specified herein - tickets may be purchased only from the Ring Office on Show days.

**ANIMAL INDEMNITY AND WAIVER:** Each competitor MUST sign an 'Animal Indemnity and Waiver' before entering the Ring.

**NAME CARDS:** Each competitor must carry a fully completed 'name' card into the ring for each event. The cards are available free from the Ring Office.

**HORSE STALLS & STALLION BOXES:** To ensure accommodation, owners may reserve stalls and boxes with the Secretary prior to the Show.

**FEES:** Horse Stalls and Stallion Boxes are free. No fees to be paid.

**GENERAL CONDITIONS:** The use of electric fences on the Showground is prohibited. All competitors ride at their own risk. The Committee reserves the right to add or delete any event as it thinks fit. Competitors' attention is drawn to the Conditions on the Horse Stall Reservation Form, the reverse of Ring Entry Tickets/Entry Forms and the Regulations listed here and elsewhere in the schedule.

**SHOWJUMPING REGULATIONS:** Showjumping to be judged under E.F.A. Rules. All jumping horses are to be registered with the E.F.A. Riders must produce their registration card at time of entry; prizemoney will not be paid until the performance card has been presented to and signed by the Judge. All riders must provide verification of their financial membership of the E.F.A. before competing. Competitors are requested to walk the course 15 minutes before the scheduled starting time.

## DEFINITIONS:

Ponies or horses must nominate in either Show Hunter Classes or Hack Classes.

Horses in appropriate classes must be registered with their Breed Societies and copies of Registration must be available for presentation.

**Novice:** Open to all competitors who have not won a first prize in a solo event at an agricultural show

**Intermediate classes** are for horses which have never been placed, i.e., won a ribbon, in an individual class at any Royal Show.

Stallions and Colts may only compete in classes where specifically permitted. Ridden Stallion classes must be ridden by a rider 17 years and over.

**Local Events:** Local horses and their riders must be resident within the Liverpool Shire Council for a period of not less than three months before the show.

## PROHIBITED DRUGS

It is the intention of these regulations that all animals shall perform on their merits without the aid of drugs which will affect the conduct, performance and appearance of the animal.

An exhibitor shall NOT administer and shall procure that there shall NOT be administered to his/her exhibit any drug or substance herein called a 'prohibited drug'.

Prohibited drugs are substances originating externally whether or not they are endogenous to the animal and means any substances capable of affecting the performance or behaviour of an animal by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system, the cardio-vascular system, the respiratory system, the alimentary-digestive system, the musculo-skeletal system or the urogenital system and SHALL INCLUDE analgesics, anti-histamines, anti-inflammatory agents, blood coagulants, diuretics, hormones and their synthetic counterparts, cortico-steroids, anabolic steroids, local anaesthetics, muscle relaxants and tranquillisers and vitamins.

The use of antibiotic substances (anti-viral, anti-microbial, anti-parasitic) with the exception of procaine penicillin may be permitted.

In the case of Showjumping and dressage entries ONLY, which are conducted under F.E.I. Rules, the use of phenylbutazone and oxyphenylbutazone is permitted provided the maximum level of either or both does not exceed 2 micrograms per millilitre of plasma, in aggregate, at the time in which the exhibit is to be judged.

The Quirindi Show Society Inc (or Central Northern Group of Show Societies Inc) may at its discretion cause an examination to be made of an exhibit by a veterinary officer who in the course of such examination may make by such methods as he/she may determine such tests of and take such samples from such exhibit as he/she deems necessary or advisable. The result of the examination shall be reported to the Group and the Society.

An exhibit to which, in the opinion of the veterinary officer, a prohibited drug has been administered shall not be exhibited without the consent of the Group and shall be removed from the showground forthwith upon notice from the Group or Society.

The Group may at its sole discretion impose the penalties applicable in the light of all information made available and may disallow or cancel the entry and any award made to the exhibit, without in such case being called upon to give reason therefore.

The owner or any other person who was in charge of the animal to which a prohibited drug has been administered will be disqualified and penalties shall apply.

THE PENALTIES TO APPLY SHALL BE 12 months' disqualification from exhibiting within this Group for the animal and the person in charge of the animal. It will be recommended to the Agricultural Societies' Council of N.S.W. that these penalties shall apply on a state-wide level and that disqualification should be state-wide.

If the animal is not presented for examination within the time specified by the Group, then the same penalties shall apply as if a prohibited drug was detected.

NO 'TREATMENT FORMS' will be acceptable.

Any person who at any time administers or causes to be administered for the purpose of affecting the performance of an animal in any event or class at the Show any drug as defined previously or has in his/her possession any improper contrivance may be disqualified or otherwise penalized by the Group.

Particular attention will be paid to the detection of sedative and tranquilliser groups of drugs but analysis for all classes of prohibited substances will be included. The collection of samples, inter alia, will always involve taking urine and/or blood.

An examination may include an examination for desensitised limbs. Any animal found to have a limb or part of a limb desensitised by any means will be considered to have competed under the influence of a prohibited substance and penalized accordingly.

The owner or his/her representative may be present during testing, but shall not interfere in any way with the conduct of the test, and will observe the instructions of the veterinary officer on duty.

The Society (or Group) and any servant or appointee of the Society or Group shall not be liable to the exhibitor, owner or other interested parties, for the death of, or for any injury, damage or infection which may be sustained by an exhibit occasioned by or arising out of any act or omission of any servant, agent or appointee of the Society or Group done or committed in the course of his/her examination whether due to the negligence of any such servant, agent or appointee or otherwise.

Exhibitors must abide by the directions of the Society or Group as to the procedures to be followed for the examination of their exhibit and failure to adhere to this direction shall incur the same penalties as if prohibited drugs were detected.

**Every horse** will require a Travelling Horse Statement. This will need to be carried with the horse and will need to be presented at the main gate when entering the grounds on the day.
